Rand will outperform other EM currencies next year, SocGen says

The rand will outperform emerging-market currencies in the coming year, supported by higher interest rates and China's infrastructure stimulus, according to Societe Generale SA strategists. They're predicting a 3.5% gain by year-end, compared with an average 2.5% losses on average for other emerging-market currencies.

HEADLINE CPI: The CPI calculates the cost to purchase a fixed basket of goods as a way of determining how much inflation is occurring in the broad economy. The CPI uses a base year and indexes current year prices based on the base year's values.

CORE CPI: The headline figure is not adjusted for seasonality or for the often volatile elements of food and energy prices, which are removed in the Core CPI.

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
