GDP beats forecasts despite war hit

South Africa's economy expanded slightly more than expected in the first quarter despite early headwinds from the Iran war, but the numbers masked underlying weakness in domestic demand. Gross domestic product grew 0.5% in the three months through March, compared with 0.4% in the prior quarter, Statistics South Africa said in a report released in the capital, Pretoria, on Tuesday. That beat the 0.3% median estimate of 15 economists in a Bloomberg survey. On a year-over-year basis, output rose 1.9% in the first quarter compared with 0.8% in the previous three months. Economists in the survey had predicted 1.7% growth.
